#### Hailsham

A few projects MiH has supported in the Wealden priority areas.....

#### Crowborough

- \* The community orchard has received a Next Steps grant to continue their development. They have been planting fruit and other trees with the local school and members of the community.
- The Wildlife group is helping to get the new nature space ready for the public and is working with a local business to help make their grounds more bio-diverse.
- The skate park re-development in Jarvis
  Brook has got the go ahead to raise funds.
  This will involve some great community
  engagement. Making it Happen is
  supporting them in their way forward.

## Polegate

The Friends of Polegate Jubilee Nature Reserve (FPJNR) is now a fully constituted group and is working hard to make the nature reserve accessible for the wider community. Polegate Town Council own the land and were keen to create a community led project, with support from AirS, Making it Happen and Sacred Earth. We are also pleased to hear about the development of Polegate Scarecrows into the Polegate Community Foundation and look forward to working with them again.

- Action Community Together (ACT) was supported with a small sparks grant to set up a free preloved uniform bank based at the Gospel Mission on Station Road.
- Plot 50 community allotment has a next steps grant to improve access and encourage more of the community to get involved with its growth.
  - Power of Plants is growing plants and then using them to make crafts and other products. They are collaborating with Plot 50, to the benefit of both groups. Making it happen is supporting this activity and they are looking at a next steps grant for this.

### Uckfield



- Uckfield Green partnership is developing its own constitution to become a formal group
  - Uckfield now has warm hubs on every day of the week. Numbers of users are increasing and they have formed a network to support each other.
- Selby Meadow continues to host the parent and toddler drop in "Out and About" on Wednesday mornings, weather permitting.
- Churchcoombe Community Association are looking for new volunteers and ideas for future activity. They would love to hear from local residents who might be interested.
